• Mentorship Officer (McKinley)


- o McKinley has partnered with NU Wellness to teach workshops for Planetree!
- O Student Wellness: "Lunch & Learns" = McKinley would be basically seeing how they do it, so we can start on this for a November workshop
 - To work with MComm to create flyers about it
- O Mentorship: 2 responses so far for people wanting to be mentees, but no mentors signed up.
 - Joe's idea: Get rid of mentorship idea, and instead have it as an educational role to connect with different opportunities, workshops, etc.
 - McKinley agrees! Wants to really promote mental health. Need to work on de-stigmatizing certain elements of mental health. Just like how we have Planetree integrated in every syllabus, we should also work with faculty and the school to add mental health on there! For example "If you or someone you know is struggling with mental health, here is information..." Joe to work on this.
- O Motion to change mentorship officer name to "Wellness & Support Officer"
 - All in favor. None opposed. Motion passes.
- o Alex appointed as the new Wellness & Support officer! Congratulations!

• Student Rep Officer (Ana)


